Getting Started

Step 1: Log In

Select InCommon in the login box drop down menu located in the upper left-hand corner of the site, and click Login.

Step 2: Select your Institution

Select your institution from the drop down menu and click Login.



Step 3: Log In

Go to your institution's research website and select the link provided to access **Research.gov**.

You will be taken to a page where you will enter your institution-issued user ID and password in the appropriate fields and select **Login**.

Step 4: Activate Your Account


Click **Activate Now** on the right side of the Research.gov page, under the Account Activation section, to go to the "Activate Your Account" page.



Step 5: Agree to Rules of Behavior


Read the Rules of Behavior and click the **Activate** button.

You will be redirected to the NSF Account Activation Page.



Step 6: Enter Your NSF Account Information


Enter the requested information in the appropriate fields (last name, NSF ID, and password) and select **Submit**. You will receive a message stating that your activation was submitted successfully.



Step 7: Access Research.gov Grants Management Services

You will now be logged into Research.gov and your Grants Application Dashboard will be displayed.

Note: You are only required to complete steps 2 – 5 during initial account activation. You will arrive directly at this page after your next login from your institution web page once your NSF account is activated.






Access FastLane via Research.gov
