

Grants Application Status allows Sponsored Projects Offices (SPOs) and Principal Investigators (PIs) to check the status of grant applications submitted to the National Science Foundation (NSF), the Department of Defense's Army Research Office (DoD/ARO) and the Department of Agriculture's Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Service (USDA/CSREES).

Grants Application Status is now available to applicants of these agencies on Research.gov! In order to access this service, you must be a registered Research.gov user. Instructions for obtaining a log-in and accessing the Grants Application Status service are available on the Research.gov site (www.research.gov).

Powering Knowledge and Innovation

Grants Application Status displays all applications submitted to:

- NSF via Grants.gov or FastLane
- USDA/CSREES via Grants.gov since October 2006
- DoD/ARO via Grants.gov, email, or paper submission since October 2008

This online service allows users to view the status of all grant applications for their organizations submitted to participating agencies. With Grants Application Status you can:

- Check on the status of applications as agencies receive and review them
- View a consolidated list of grant applications submitted to NSF, DoD/ARO, and USDA/CSREES
- View detailed application status history from submission to review to decision
- Maintain a single Log-in ID to view applications at both agencies
- Search and sort applications by multiple fields (e.g., agency, tracking number, and received date)
- View panel reviews (if applicable and a PI on the grant application)
